

Vitalizer® in Space

Astronaut Captain Mark Kelly shown here with a sheet of Vitalizer® floating beside him was a speaker at the Shaklee Global Conference in August. He was the captain of the historic final NASA mission on July 8, 2011 and has been into space more than any other astronaut. Many people know him as the husband of Arizona Congresswoman Gabrielle Giffords who was shot earlier this year. On NASA's final mission, Captain Kelly personally shot video of Vitalizer® vitamins in orbit.
